<ul> <li>Supports available for student mental health.</li> <li>Accommodations for students with pre-existing medical conditions are available.</li> <li>Student support services will continue following enhanced guidelines.</li> <li>All staff and students entering the school will complete AHS Daily Screen Checklist or the visitors will complete the BTPS COVID-19 APP.</li> <li>Any student ill at school will be isolated and picked up within an hour.</li> <li>BTPS will work in conjunction with Alberta Health Services and Alberta Education if COVID-19 is identified within our schools</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>As much as possible classes and all courses will continue following specific guidelines.</li> <li>Before entering and exiting the class, proper hand hygiene must be followed.</li> <li>Some learning opportunities may be:         <ul> <li>Outside, virtual, theory (over practical)</li> <li>No fall performances of music, dance, theatre.</li> <li>Alternate learning options for students are available through Students Online School.</li> <li>Sports follow ASAA and Alberta Education guidelines.</li> <li>PATs and DIPs will be completed in June, 2021.</li> <li>No field trips for fall 2020 which require a bus.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Staggered start for beginning the school year.</li> <li>Proper hand hygiene will be followed.</li> <li>Materials organized per student where possible.</li> <li>High touch areas cleaned throughout day.</li> <li>Soft furnishings and rugs removed from classroom.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>All students must complete the <u>AHS</u> <u>Daily Screen Checklist</u> at home.</li> <li>Grades 4-12 students and all staff will wear masks when: On bus, entering school, in common areas and when physical distancing is not possible.</li> <li>Students to bring a full water bottle.</li> <li>Classes and buses will have seating plans.</li> <li>Teachers will move to students where possible.</li> <li>Minimal number of adults with a group of students.</li> <li>Signs and direction arrows may direct flow of traffic.</li> <li>Recess and lunches may be staggered.</li> <li>Daily drop off and pick up designated.</li> <li>Microwaves and vending machines removed for September.</li> <li>No sharing of food or utensils.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Provincially recommended sanitizer and cleaning supplies.</li> <li>Hand sanitizer at entry of school and in classrooms.</li> <li>Custodian available throughout day for high touch area cleaning.</li> <li>Proper hand hygiene required before entering and exiting school, classrooms, any equipment is shared and before eating.</li> <li>Shared equipment regularly cleaned.</li> <li>No non-essential items allowed at school (ie toys).</li> <li>Strict illness procedures established in schools.</li> <li>Soft furnishings and rugs removed from classroom.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Visitor access will be limited until further notice.</li> <li>All visitors must:</li> <li>Use front entrance. Wear a mask. Complete the BTPS COVID-19 APP. Follow proper hand hygiene procedure.</li> <li>Extra-curricular activities will adhere to all guidelines for the activity.</li> <li>School Councils recommended to meet online.</li> <li>Before and After School Programs follow specific sector guidelines.</li> <li>Private programs and partnerships may continue.</li> <li>Outside user groups suspended for fall 2020.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>BTPS Re-Entry Plan Completed.</li> <li>All schools will have the BTPS Visitor sign posted.</li> <li>Schools have individual Re-Entry Plans posted on their websites.</li> <li>BTPS follows the recommendations and guidelines of Alberta Health.</li> <li>BTPS follows the recommendations and guidelines of Alberta Education School Re-Entry Plan.</li> </ul>
